World Budget Offering (Emphasis: Christian Record Services, Inc.) Christian Record Annual Day of Giving Important Dates

Maddox is a child who happens to be blind.

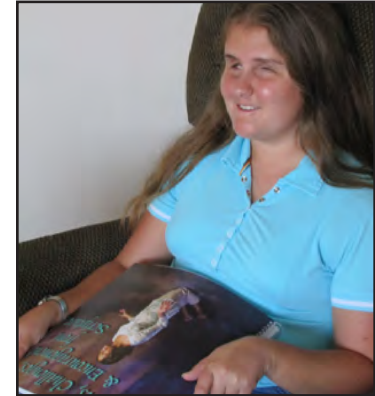

- He received an audio Bible from Christian Record at summer camp.

All services and programs are offered free of charge to individuals who are blind. Generous financial sponsor support enables Christian Record to provide these services and programs.

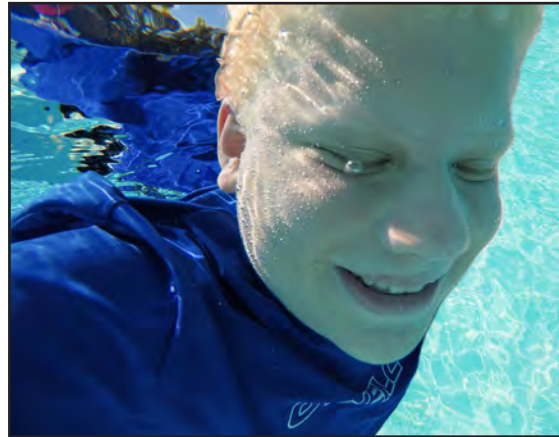
